### VERY URGENT EX PARTE MOTION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Petitioners Edward L. Du aud Nomad Sports Club ("Club"), by counsel, respectfully state:

- 1. On 7 April 2010, petitioners filed a Petition for the annulment of all ultra vires acts of the Board of Directors of petitioner Club with prayer for the issuance of a writ of preliminary injunction.
- 2. Respondents already made an initial payment of \$25,050,000.00 and paid another installment in the approximate amount of \$20,000,000.00 sometime in March 2010. Petitioners subsequently learned that the respondents are undertaking to make another payment in a substantial amount in the month of April.

- 3. This matter is of extreme urgency as the petitioner, as well as its members, shall suffer grave and irreparable injury unless respondents are restrained from pursuing the purchase of the property subject of this action, including the payments of installments pursuant thereto as well as all negotiations for the financing thereof.
  - 3.1. Unless the subject acts sought to be prevented are immediately curtailed, respondents intend to undertake a sale that is void for want of the qualification to own private land under the Constitution and for lack of ratification of the stockholders warranted by the Corporation Code. Unless restrained, respondents shall be successful in consummating the purchase of the Subject Property in violation of the constitutional prohibition.
  - 3.2. In addition, as shown in the Petition, petitioner Club does not have the financial capacity to shoulder the very first payment of P35,050,000.00. Any additional financial burden will surely cause the bankruptcy of petitioner Club. With the prohibition against its acquisition of private lands, petitioner Club may not even have any asset to hold onto.
- 4. Thus, it is imperative that the Honorable Court issue a temporary restraining order for 20 days to avert respondents from causing grave and irreparable damage to petitioner Club.

#### PRAYER

WHEREPORE, petitioners Edward L. Du and Nomad Sports Club respectfully pray that upon the filing of this Motion, the Flonorable Court issue a temporary restraining order effective for a period of 20 days from service thereof to restrain the respondents from purchasing the Subject Properties, including any payments and all negotiations for the financing thereof.

Petitioners further pray for such other just and equitable relicf under the premises.
